

Theme for parade is 'Christmas Memories'

The theme for this year's Apopka Christmas Parade will be "Christmas Memories" and the event is once again sponsored by the Foliage Sertoma Club of Apopka.

As is tradition, the parade is scheduled for the second Saturday of the month, which is December 14. It will step off at 10 a.m. and participants will traverse the usu-

al parade route from Third Street north along Park Avenue to Votaw Road. Traditionally, the parade lasts about two hours.

The annual Christmas Parade is intended to encourage community support and celebration of the holiday season. It is sponsored for the enjoyment of families and children of all ages, and the Foliage Sertoma Club joins with the com-

munity in seeking a parade of participants for all to enjoy. The inclusion of five marching bands help make it one of the largest parades in the Central Florida area, and position in the parade is determined by the order in which applications are received.

Deadline for submitting entry forms is November 20, or until all 100 positions are filled, whichever

comes first.

For-profit entries are \$75 and non-profit entries are \$50. Checks should be made payable to the Foliage Sertoma Club of Apopka. Entry applications are available from the office of Steven R. Deviese, C.P.A., parade chairman.

Orange County gets federal grant of \$200,000 to add outdoor air quality monitoring station

Orange County's Environmental Protection Division was recently awarded a federal grant to add an outdoor air quality monitoring station in order to measure air quality impacts from vehicle traffic. Due to population growth, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is funding a fourth air quality monitoring station to be installed near an Orange County roadway to monitor peak nitrogen dioxide levels. Nitrogen dioxide (NO2) is a typical pollutant emitted from gas-powered vehicles.

For this project, Or-

ange County has already received \$50,000 in federal grant funding from the EPA. An additional \$150,000 from the grant will cover the purchase of monitoring equipment and installation of a small protective building on the site. The grant does not require the county to use any matching funds. The EPA and Orange County Environmental Protection Division's goal is to have a new monitoring site location selected by mid-2020, and for it to become operational in 2021.

Air pollutants come from many sources such

as vehicle exhaust, dust, and emissions from commercial activities. Scientists and engineers at Orange County's Environmental Protection Division routinely work with the USEPA and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection in efforts to continuously monitor air quality, enforce ordinances and implement programs designed to protect the health of county residents.

Air quality in Orange County typically falls within the Air Quality Index "good" range. To check the current Air Quality Index, visit the Air Now website

at www.airnow.gov. Citizens can also subscribe to Enviroflash.info to have daily air quality forecasts sent via email and/or text message.

MAYOR'S PROCLAMATION
 MARCH 17, 2020
CITY GENERAL ELECTION, CITY OF APOPKA, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Charter, Code of Ordinances, and Ordinance No. 2733 of the City of Apopka, Florida, an election shall be held on March 17, 2020, at which election there shall be elected a Commissioner for Seat 3, and a Commissioner for Seat 4, both for four year terms; and

WHEREAS, the terms of office of Commissioner Seat 3, and Commissioner Seat 4 will expire at 12:00 p.m. on April 28, 2020, it is therefore necessary that a Commissioner for Seat 3 and a Commissioner for Seat 4 be elected at an election of the City of Apopka, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, **BRYAN NELSON, MAYOR** of the City of Apopka, Florida, as required by law, do hereby proclaim and pronounce that an election will be held in the City of Apopka, Florida, on Tuesday, **March 17, 2020**, from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m., for the purpose of electing a Commissioner for Seat 3, and a Commissioner for Seat 4. Voting precincts will be determined by the Orange County Supervisor of Elections.

Early voting will be available through the Orange County Supervisor of Elections Office, and will coincide with their designated sites and times, from Monday, March 2, 2020, through Sunday, March 15, 2020.

Only the voters of the City residing within the City limits who are properly registered with the Orange County Supervisor of Elections, or who will be properly registered by February 18, 2020, may vote in this election.

Candidates for said offices must qualify with the City Clerk beginning at 12:00 p.m. on Monday, December 2, 2019, and ending at 12:00 p.m. on Monday, December 9, 2019, at City Hall, 120 E. Main Street, Apopka, Florida.

The Orange County Canvassing Board is hereby authorized to canvass the City of Apopka ballots voted in the March 17, 2020 city general election in compliance with Ordinance No. 2733 and Section 30-26, Apopka Code of Ordinances.

In the event it becomes necessary to have a run-off election, this will be held on Tuesday, April 14, 2020, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Precinct 9104, Apopka Community Center, 519 South Central Avenue, Apopka, Florida, and Precinct 9204, Northwest Recreation, 3710 Jason Dwellley, Apopka, Florida. Early voting will be available through the Orange County Supervisor of Elections Office, 119 West Kaley Street, Orlando, Florida, Monday, April 6, 2020, through Friday, April 10, 2020, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
