# Mustangs fall two points shy of third state championship

The St. Thomas Aquinas Raiders stopped the Wekiva Mustangs' attempted run to a state championship by a 62-60 score. Drama and theater were also at the highest of levels throughout the Class 6A state championship final on Saturday, February 27. However, as close as possible to the finish was where the drama and theatre ended. Five consecutive points scored by the Raiders during the last 1:59 determined the outcome.

Appearing in the 2021 final was the fifth time for Wekiva during the past nine seasons that included two state championships. The past two seasons, however, have ended with disappointing and emotionally painful state championship final losses for the Mustangs. The outcome of last season's state championship final was determined during the final half-minute as well. St. Thomas Aquinas (STA) of Fort Lauderdale had appeared in two

previous state championship finals without a victory.

"Everything a final is supposed to be, from the emotion to the physical on both sides," Butts said. "No pauses in terms of the swings going back and forth, the score and the emotion propelling the score. For every time physical contact was initiated, the emotion was as much. Players fought tooth-and-nail. Nothing was left in the tank. I cannot complain about the effort and energy played with.

"Use the loss as an experience going into next year was the message in the locker room. Will this situation fuel the players' fire? A learning experience for our girls and hopefully we can close the deal next year after the previous two."

Two starters for the Mustangs had fouled out with two minutes remaining in the contest and the disadvantage in fouls at the end of the contest was 24-16. Yet, Wekiva had gnashed, muscled, and willed itself into the 60-57 lead. A position from which winning what would have been the one last victory needed to complete the season-long mission of unfinished business had been created by the Mustangs.

Defense carried both teams throughout the regular season and into the state championship final. Wekiva's was slightly more potent through the first 30 minutes of the state championship final, though, and

# Darters still unbeaten after 3 victories, including no-hitter

The Apopka Blue Darters baseball team remained undefeated with three victories over the past week, including back-to-back shutouts where Apopka's pitchers allowed just one run over 14 innings.

The Blue Darters (7-0) began the week with a 6-2 victory over Lake Nona, then two pitchers combined for a no-hitter in a 9-0 victory over St. Cloud before allowing East Ridge just one hit in a 4-0 win by the Blue Darters.

Two Apopka pitchers combined to hurl a no-hitter against the Bulldogs while the offense gave run support early, playing six runs in the first inning of the shutout victory on Fri-

Grayson Adams picked up the victory with five innings of work and Anthony DeVita secured the no-hitter in his two innings on the

mound.

It was the first outing of the season for Adams, so he came out of the game after delivering 65 pitches.

# Two homers, shutout pitching lead to 3-0 win over W. Springs

Getting a pair of home runs from Aubrey Evans and a four-hit shutout from starting pitcher Abigail Ellison, the Apopka Blue Darters (4-2) softball team got back on the winning track to defeat Winter Springs, 3-0, on Tuesday, March 2.

Evans' first homer came in the bottom of the first inning when she followed Jesi Mora, who had led off the inning with a single. Evans crushed the ball over the centerfield fence to give the Blue Darters a 2-0 lead.

Meanwhile, Ellison held the Bears to four hits, fanning two and walking no Winter Springs batters.

Evans added a solo homer in the third inning to account for the final Apopka run.

Defensively, the Blue Darters turned a key double play in the first inning and had no errors in the field.

The victory over Winter Springs followed a disappointing 6-5 loss to Lake Howell on Friday, February 26. Apopka

had taken 5-2 lead with three runs in the sixth inning and two more in the top of the seventh but gave up four runs in the bottom of the seventh. The Blue Darters committed four errors.

Coach Mike MacWithey's team will play today, Friday, March 5, and Saturday, March 6, in the MAIST Tournament at Montverde Academy in Lake County.

Apopka will play Montverde Academy today, Friday, March 5, in a 6 p.m. game and then will face Episcopal School of Jacksonville on Saturday, March 6, at noon. They'll follow that with a 7 p.m. game against Middleburg.

The Blue Darters will travel to Lake Mary on Wednesday, March 10, for a 7 p.m. game and then play at rival West Orange on Thursday, March 11, at 6 p.m. in the final two games prior to spring break.

The first game after spring break will be a 7 p.m. contest on March 24 at home against Ocoee.

# Mustangs: There was contact on Wekiva’s final possession, but no call

the next Raiders’ possession ended with a turnover.

However, the impact of defense changed immediately to St. Thomas Aquinas’ favor. The Mustangs missed two field goal attempts and committed three turnovers during the last 1:59.

The first missed field goal from Wekiva during the final two minutes occurred on the subsequent possession.

Free throws converted by STA’s Samara Smith on the subsequent possession cut the Mustangs’ lead to 60-59. Turnovers brought the next three successive possessions to an end. Wekiva turned the ball over last during the three-possession stretch on an errant out-of-bounds pass. The basket was attacked by Spencer once again via the left side of the baseline after receiving the inbound pass. Twenty-two seconds later and with 58 seconds left, what would be the winning points were scored via a layup using the backboard by Spencer.

However, the outcome was finally decided on the Mustangs’ last possession. Shaniyah McCarthy and K’Nari Holliday attempted to complete an inbound pass to the left side of the basket along the baseline. A completed pass would have left Holliday with possession of the ball and the opportunity to execute the traditional big man move, a 180-spin into the basket.

Jada Green reached around Holliday while in one-on-one coverage and tipped the pass into Holliday’s body. Then the ball bounced off Holliday

and out of play. During the process of tipping the ball, Green touched Holliday’s body with the arm and hand. Referees ruled amount of physical contact or intensity was not enough to be considered a foul.

“Contact was initiated in my opinion,” Butts said. “However, scoring on the last possession wasn’t the only opportunity we had to win. We created other opportunities previously to score that weren’t completed and had the cumulative effect. No call was neither here nor there in the context of the whole contest.

“Get the ball to K’Nari inside. Odds of scoring on the play is in our favor was the thought. Opportunity to use the play was called throughout the contest. We

had gone to our inside game throughout the contest with good results. Give credit to Green and St. Thomas Aquinas for not letting up on the intensity and taking advantage of failed opportunities changing who (team) had to make a play. A situation which the Raiders could take advantage of was opened by us failing to score on the previous possessions. Crowding the area on the floor the ball was supposed to be moved by St. Thomas Aquinas made scoring more difficult, but not impossible. However, no attempt at compensating just a couple of inches was made.”

Five more turnovers were also at least indirectly connected to the number of fouls and free throws at-

tempted having an important role in the outcome. The turnover committed by the Mustangs on the last possession was the 19th in total compared to 14 for the Raiders. In particular, St. Thomas Aquinas’ lower percentage was negated by a higher amount taken. Percentage at the free throw line for the Mustangs was 60 percent as 14-of-20 attempts were converted. The answer from St. Thomas Aquinas was 17-of-34 or 50 percent.

Field goal percentage was 42-37 in favor of the Mustangs. Means for overcoming the difference in field goal percentage was attempting more. A difference of five among turnovers provided the opportunity for St. Thomas Aquinas to attempt two more field goal attempts. The Mustangs converted 22-of-42 field goal attempts. STA converted 20-of-54 field attempts.

Rebounds were slightly on the Raiders’ side as well at 39-37. In particular, though, a 15-10 margin was held by St. Thomas Aquinas in offensive rebounds. Points were scored by the Raiders after 10 offensive rebounds compared to eight for the Mustangs.

“Like a 50/50 ball, this was a contest in which when looking at the skills and talents as well as intensity played with most of the possessions in general could have gone either way,” Butts said. “The 2021 state championship final from our perspective was determined by who executed the action which allowed the possession to change from either way to in the favor of a team. Each possession during this state

championship final was a contest and an outcome unto itself.

“So, failing to finish was not only in terms of looking at the contest and final score as a whole. Those two specific possessions after the lead grew to 60-57 weren’t finished. We didn’t capture the moment during those two possessions in which the either way changes to leaning toward a team.

The moment was captured by St. Thomas Aquinas though. Number of plays were only two. However, as the tournament progresses, difference between outcomes become less and less. Then time was equally important. Leading by three or four points is huge with 1:30 left. The Raiders need to create at least one more possession than us in only 1:30 and foul. Control of the strategy and free throws remains with us.”

Wekiva built an 11-4 lead with 5:50 left in the first quarter, the largest of the contest. Nor did the Mustangs trail until 61-60 with 58 seconds left. However, the fourth quarter saw three ties and five lead

changes. At the end of each quarter, scores were 14-13, 31-30, and 45-43, all in favor of Wekiva.

The District 6A-4 championship tournament was claimed by Wekiva with victories over South Lake and Mainland. Atlantic Coast, Daytona Beach Mainland, Santa Rosa County Navarre, and Winter Haven (state semifinals) fell to Wekiva during the FHSAA postseason tournament.

Due to COVID-19, finalists from each of the 16 districts across the state qualified for the FHSAA postseason tournament. St. Thomas Aquinas defeated Davie Nova to advance to the District 6A-14 championship tournament final and qualify for the FHSAA postseason tournament.

This particular recipe is Adeline Bronson's Chicken and Yellow Rice. It is quite simple and baked for an hour at 400 degrees in a casserole dish. It is wonderful for your everyday meals or special guests.

We have an interestingly named recipe for you: Jail-House Chili. The publication, *Paths of Sunshine*, is from the Florida Federation of Garden Clubs. If you don't like really highly seasoned food, you might want to cut down the cayenne pepper.

Spinach Squares from *The Jones-Morris Family Treasury* is a treat that is not only delicious but wonderfully convenient in that you can fix it ahead of time and even freeze it and then reheat them when you need them.

From Southern Living, we have a skillet dish, Cabbage-Onion-Sweet Pepper Medley. It uses bacon, the drippings from which you use to sauté the vegetables prior to cooking.

*Cooking with Foliage La Sertoma of Apopka* shares a vegetable dish called Zucchini Donatone. The sauce can be prepared the day before you want to bake it.

## ADELINE BRONSON'S CHICKEN AND YELLOW RICE

Recipe from  
The Apopka Woman's Club  
**WHAT'S COOKIN'?**

**2 fryers, halved**  
**1/2 cup olive oil**  
**2 cups chopped onions**  
**1 green pepper, cut up**  
**2 cloves garlic**  
**2-1/2 cups rice**  
**2 cups canned tomatoes**  
**5 cups hot water**  
**2 bay leaves**  
**1/2 teaspoon saffron**  
**1 cup green peas**  
**2 teaspoons salt**

## 1/4 teaspoon pepper

Brown the chicken in olive oil. Remove to casserole. Brown onions, green pepper and garlic for about five minutes. Add to chicken in casserole along with all remaining ingredients. Cover and bake in 400-degree oven for one hour.

## JAIL-HOUSE CHILI

Recipe from  
Florida Federation of Garden Clubs,  
**Paths of Sunshine Cookbook**

**1/2 cup olive oil**  
**3 pounds lean beef, diced**  
**1 quart water**  
**8 chili pods (or 6 tablespoons chili powder)**  
**3 teaspoons salt**  
**10 cloves garlic, finely chopped**  
**1 teaspoon cumin**  
**1 teaspoon oregano**  
**1 teaspoon cayenne pepper**  
**1 tablespoon sugar**  
**3 tablespoons paprika (for color)**  
**3 tablespoons flour**  
**6 tablespoons cornmeal**  
**1 cup water**

In a 6-quart pot, heat the oil and add the meat to sear over high heat, stirring constantly until the meat is grey – not brown. Add water, cover and cook at a bubbling simmer 1-1/2 to 2 hours. Add all other ingredients except the thickening (flour and cornmeal). Cook at simmer for another 30 minutes. If much fat was left on the meat, it will rise to the top after the spices have been added. Skim fat before thickening. Mix flour and cornmeal with 1 cup water. Add to chili mixture, stirring constantly to prevent sticking. Cook 5 minutes more to determine if more water is necessary to reach desired consistency. This is fairly hot chili, above average. Serves 6.

## SANDRA JOHANSEN'S SPINACH SQUARES

Recipe from  
*The Jones-Morris Family Treasury*

**2 packages frozen chopped spinach**  
**1 pound (or at least 10 ounces) mild cheddar cheese, grated**  
**4 tablespoons butter**  
**3 eggs**  
**1 cup flour**  
**1 teaspoon salt**  
**1 teaspoon baking powder**  
**1 tablespoon chopped onion (optional)**  
**Seasoned salt**

Thaw chopped spinach by letting it sit at room temperature. Put butter into 9 x 13-inch pan and place pan in oven to

melt. Watch that it doesn't burn.

In large bowl, beat eggs well. Mix together dry ingredients and add to eggs all at once; mix well. Add cheese and spinach, breaking it up with your hands. Blend mixture all together. Add onion and seasoned salt at this point. Spoon into pan and smooth out with spatula. Bake in 350-degree oven for 35 minutes or until top browns (some, not too much). Let cool 45 minutes, then cut into squares like brownies.

**Note: Great for buffets.** These spinach squares freeze well. You can use as many or as few as you need. Simply reheat at 325 degrees for about 12 minutes. Alternatively, you can reheat in a microwave oven on a paper plate for JUST A FEW MINUTES.

## CABBAGE-ONION-SWEET PEPPER MEDLEY

Recipe from  
*Southern Living All-Time Favorites*

**1/2 small sweet red pepper**  
**1/2 small sweet yellow pepper**  
**1/2 small green pepper**  
**2 slices bacon**  
**1 onion, chopped**  
**2 cups shredded cabbage**  
**3 tablespoons white vinegar**  
**1 tablespoon vegetable oil**  
**1 tablespoon water**  
**1-1/2 teaspoons brown sugar**  
**1-1/2 teaspoons Dijon mustard**  
**1/2 teaspoon salt**  
**1/2 teaspoon pepper**

Cut peppers into 2-inch long thin strips; cut bacon into 1-inch pieces.

Cook bacon in a large skillet until crisp. Add pepper strips, onion, and cabbage, tossing gently.

Combine vinegar and remaining six ingredients in a jar; cover tightly, and shake vigorously. Add to vegetable mixture in skillet, stirring gently.

Bring to a boil; cover, reduce heat, and simmer eight minutes or until cabbage is tender, stirring occasionally. Serve immediately.

Makes 3 servings.

## ZUCCHINI DONATONE

Recipe from *Cooking With Foliage La Sertoma of Apopka*

**1 pound can Italian peeled tomatoes**  
**1 6-ounce can tomato paste**  
**1 tablespoon finely chopped onion**  
**1 teaspoon celery salt**  
**1 teaspoon sugar**  
**1 teaspoon garlic salt**  
**1 small jar pimento, chopped**  
**1 green pepper, finely chopped**

## 2 pounds zucchini

## 1 bay leaf

## 1 cup Italian bread crumbs

## 2 slices of Mozzarella cheese

Chop tomatoes and combine with the next nine ingredients. Simmer slowly for 1 hour. This may be done the day before and refrigerated. Wash zucchini, but do not peel. Cut into half-inch thick slices. Saute for 5 minutes in melted butter laced with garlic salt, turning once.

Drain and put into a 1-quart casserole. Remove bay leaf from sauce and pour over zucchini.

Evenly sprinkle Italian bread crumbs over top, placing slices of Mozzarella cheese over the crumbs. Bake in a 400-degree preheated oven for 30 minutes. Makes 8 servings.

## LILLIAN CLEGHORN'S GRAPE SALAD

I hope you are havin’ a great week. Hopefully, you had a chance to get on the water and do some fishin’ over the weekend.

The fishin’ is doin’ good in most of the lakes in our area. Some nice stringers of bass are bein’ caught in the local and national tournaments that are bein’ held here in Central Florida. Mark at Big Toho Bait and Tackle reports that the guides are takin’ clients out and they are catchin’ some nice bass on shiners. The problem is there aren’t many shiners, so the

guides are limited on how many shiners they can get per trip. Folks are fishin’ are catchin’ some nice 6 pounders and 7 pounders on shiners.

Mark also reports that a few folks are gettin’ on the water early and catchin’ some nice bass on top-wa-

ter baits at first light. Once the sun gets up, you need to switch over to plastic worms to catch ’em. The best colors to use have been junebug, black blue, and blueberry.

Over at Bitter’s Bait and Tackle, Kyle reports that the folks in his area are still catchin’ some specks. Most of the specks have moved to shallow water to spawn. The best lakes to catch some specks in have been Lake Monroe and Lake Jesup. Most folks are catchin’ ’em on minners and jigs tipped with a minner. Kyle reports a few specks and some bluegills are showin’ up along

the seawall in Sanford. Kyle reports that it won’t be long before the bluegills will be showin’ up to spawn. As a matter of fact, Kyle said he has found a few bluegills showin’ up around the shell beds in the local lakes and some of the bigger chains.

Kyle reports that the bass fishin’ has been off and on in most of the lakes in our area. The Harris Chain has been very busy with tournaments held throughout the chain. It’s taken about a 20 lb. bag of five bass to get in the money, so the bass are bitin’ but you will have to look for ’em to be able to catch ’em. I was

on the chain last week and I caught a few small bass flippin’ the heavy cover throughout the Lake Dora.

The bass fishin’ has been good if you want to drag some shiners around in Lake Maitland. Kyle reports folks are freelinin’ shiners over the submerged hydrilla and eel grass beds and catchin’ some nice bass. The bass are bitin’ in the Butler Chain, too.

Central Florida Bass Hunters, a local bass club, held its monthly tournament on the Butler Chain last weekend. Congrats to Danny Mosley and Randall Faber who won the tourna-

ment with five bass that hit the scales at a total of 18.93 lbs. They also caught the biggest bass of the tournament that was caught by Randall and weighed 9.02 lbs. There was another nice bass caught durin’ the tournament that weighed more than 8 lbs.

So, the fishin’ is still doin’ good and with the warmer days ahead, the fishin’ should be good for a while. Get the family and go fishin’ over the weekend. See ya next week.

## Apopka: Darters had two shutouts, gave up just two runs in three games

es. Adams walked just one batter and struck out seven Bulldogs. DeVita fanned four and walked none. Each hit one batter. The Bulldogs had just three baserunners during the game.

“Grayson Adams hadn’t thrown an inning since the season started because of an injury so that was his first time out. He was able to continue, but he was on a pitch count. I know he had a no-hitter going,” Apopka coach Bobby Brewer said. “We brought in Anthony DeVita, who is a sophomore and he did a great job for us.”

After retiring the first two St. Cloud batters of the game on strikeouts, Adams got the third batter on a ground out, throwing just 15 pitches, but he had plenty of time to rest as his teammates got him six runs in the bottom half of the inning, sending 10 batters to the plate.

The first Apopka run came when the Blue Darters had bases loaded and one out on a misplayed fly ball off the bat of Juan Cruz. Anthony DeMilio scored from third when the St. Cloud rightfielder overran the pop up in shallow right field, giving the Darters a 1-0 lead.

After another out, designated hitter Garrett Brewer drew a bases-loaded walk to force home a run.

Jacob Pino then slapped a single to right field, scoring two more runs to give Apopka a 4-0 lead. Winston Williams followed suit with his own single to right, plating another pair of runs and setting Adams up with a 6-0 lead.

“We knew coming in these guys have been play-

ing really good and the kid they had on the mound (Clayton Boroski) actually is going to (University of) North Florida, so he’s a Division I pitcher. We jumped on him hard tonight. Our guys were ready to play,” coach Brewer said.

The Darters had runners in scoring position in the second and third innings, but couldn’t push across any runs until the bottom of the fifth when they played two more runs.

Winston Williams’ two-out double scored the runs with Cruz and Brewer scoring after Cruz had led off the inning with a double and Brewer had reached base when he was hit by a pitch.

Apopka’s final run came in the sixth inning when Gabby Lebron had a two-out single to right field to score DeMilio, who had led off the inning when he reached on an infield error.

“We hit the ball up and down the lineup all night long. We only got eight hits, but we must have hit another

five balls on the screws,” Brewer said.

Rightfielder Winston Williams was 3-for-3 at the plate with 4 RBI for the Blue Darters.

“Winston Williams tonight – we moved him down (in the lineup) the other night to let him relax a little bit and get his thoughts together – he came out and just destroyed the ball,” Brewer said.

Apopka had no errors. “We played very defense and pitching tonight was good. When we get pitching like that and we get timely hitting like that, we’re a pretty solid team,” Brewer said.

“These guys are getting tougher and they’re understanding each other more. They’re not complaining; they’re not griping. They’re just getting it done and doing the things we ask them to do. We’re becoming a pretty solid ballclub.”

### Apopka 4, East Ridge 0

The Blue Darters rode Ty Greene’s three-run home run in the first inning and

one-hit pitching by Garrett Carapreso to defeat the Knights.

After Matt Prevesk tripled to lead off the bottom of the first inning, Anthony DeMilio reached on an infield error, Greene launched a one-out rocket over the left-field fence to give the Blue Darters all the runs they would need for their seventh victory in as many games this season.

“Prevesk led it off with a ball off the wall. I thought it was gone. Ty Greene then hit one over the light pole for a three-run homer to put us up,” coach Brewer said. “We came out swinging the bats really good.”

East Ridge pitcher Kehi Louderback kept the Blue Darters at bay the rest of the way until the sixth inning when Apopka plated one more run on a single by Cruz to bring home Greene, who had slapped a two-out single, stolen second, and went to third on a passed ball.

“The kid on the mound (for East Ridge) was good. He had us out front a little bit and the zone was big behind the plate. Like I tell our guys, we can’t complain about that because the (strike) zone was big for both sides. It was big for us, too,” Brewer said.

Caropreso pitched 6-2/3 innings, allowing just a first-inning single and three walks. He fanned nine East Ridge batters. Zack Lindsay came in and got the final out, striking out the only batter he faced.

“Garrett Caropreso threw a great game for us and we brought Zack Lindsay to get that last out for us. He’s done that before for us. We’ve got so much pitching here, he (Caropreso) threw a

lot of pitches and I thought it was time to get him off the mound. He had a great game for us,” Brewer said.

“We played solid defense again. Any time you’ve got pitching and defense, you’re going to be in the ballgame. We’re right back to playing that old timey Apopka ball where we’ve got good pitching, good defense, and we hit the long ball or we hit the ball off that wall out there.”

### Apopka 6, Lake Nona 2

In the victory over Lake Nona on Thursday, February 25, the Blue Darters took a little while to get going, but took the lead for good with two runs in the third inning and three more in the fifth.

“Their guy on the mound was pretty doggone tough, too. It took us a little bit of time to figure him out. Once we got him figured out we were OK with it. We started banging the ball around a little bit,” coach Brewer said.

“We did a good job with pitching and played really good defense, and, again, had timely hitting.”

Cruz had a great night at the plate, as he was 3-for-3 with 3 RBI for the Darters. Jose Class also had three hits and 1 RBI, while DeMilio had two hits and 1 RBI. Michael Sowers had 1 RBI.

Three Apopka pitchers allowed just four runs, walking six, and striking out nine Lake Nona batters.

Ty Greene picked up the victory with three innings on the mound. Zack Lindsay hurled 3-1/3 innings, while Garrett Caropreso finished up by getting the final two outs.

Coach Brewer said he likes the way the Blue Darters are playing.

“Right now, what’s happening with us, is we’re taking bad at-bats one time and then we’re coming back and making the adjustment the second time. When you see us the second time through the lineup, we’re better because our guys are making adjustments,” he said.

“We’re not swinging at the breaking ball in the dirt much anymore. We’re back to the old Apopka baseball like it used to be where we’re trying to hit the ball over the fence out there if we can get a hold of it. We’ve got some guys on this team who have some power, but we really don’t preach home runs, we preach doubles. Hit the ball in the gaps and they’re doing that.”

The Blue Darters are getting production from up and down the lineup, coach Brewer said.

“I’d love to throw a name out there, but everybody’s jumping on board, everybody’s contributing,” he said. “They’re all buying into it and we’re going to continue to move people around. We haven’t had the same lineup two games in a row since we’ve started.”

### What’s ahead

The Blue Darters will face longtime rival West Orange today, Friday, March 5, for the only time this season in a 6 p.m. at West Orange.

“We go Friday night to West Orange and everybody knows that’s going to be a dogfight. That’s OK. We look forward to those dogfights,” coach Brewer said.

Next week, Apopka has three games in three days before taking 12 days off over spring break.

The Darters will play Monday, March 8, at

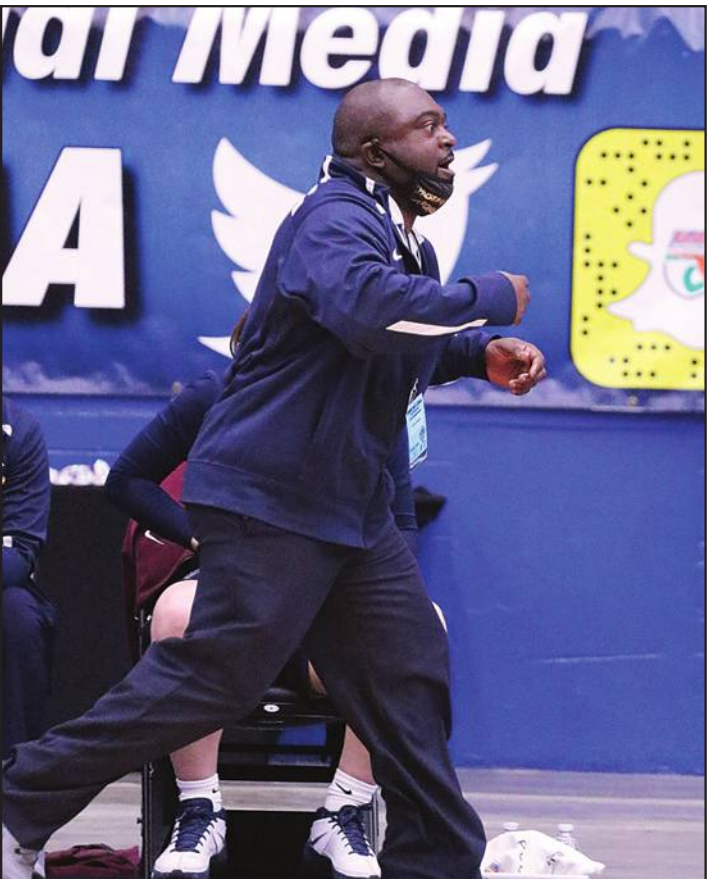
