APK boys basketball remains undefeated at Get Down Showcase

Last weekend, while sugar plums and gumdrops were still on most people's minds, it was game time for the Apopka Blue Darters boys basketball squad. The team traveled north to Gainesville for the Florida Get Down New Year's Showcase. The boys went undefeated beating both of their opponents in convincing fashion.

Starting with their first game on Friday, December 27, the boys were set to play against Business Engineering Science Tech (BEST) out of Atlanta, Georgia. BEST was ranked 89th in the state of Georgia with an 11-3 record. Even with the team being very

skilled, Apopka was able to get hot and pull away with a decisive 68-49 win defeating the BEST Eagles by nearly 20 points.

Head coach of the Apopka Blue Darters Scott Williams told me that the game against BEST was the harder-fought matchup of the two games.

"They are a pretty good team. We were finally able to pull away in the second half, and we ended up winning by 19, which was a big win for us."

Apopka's Jermichael Johnson, Jahi Bowden, and Jude Angervil all had phenomenal outings against BEST. The three of them combined for 58 of the team's 68 points. Johnson and Bowden collected 20 points each with Angervil

collecting 18.

The team's next game was set to be against the Lithonia Bulldogs out of Lithonia Georgia. On Sunday, December 29, Apopka faced Lithonia and put another win up to complete their tournament run undefeated. The Blue Darters defeated Lithonia 56-21 in a game that was over from the start.

When Williams talked about the game against Lithonia, he said that Apopka simply overwhelmed them.

"We got on them and ahead of them early, and because of that, a lot of kids got a chance to play that don't get to play a lot, and that is always good for your season and good for your kids to be able to do that."

Not only did the boys

take home two wins, but Johnson and Angervil both came away with accolades. Johnson was named All-Showcase First Team while Angervil was named All-Showcase Second Team.

One of the biggest things coach Williams said that came from the tournament was the fact that it was at Sante Fe College.

"One of the nice things about that event was that it was at Sante Fe College, where their coaching staff

was able to watch our guys along with some other recruiters so it's awesome that our seniors played well."

Williams went on to say that, "Jermichael (Johnson) was the player of the game in our first match and Larson Taylor was the player of the game in our second match. In addition, both Jude (Angervil) and Jahi (Bowden) had two outstanding games as well."

"It's a wonderful com-

pliment to both Jermichael and to Jude that they made the All-Showcase Team and they were both very deserving. So I'm excited for both of them for the second half of our season."

While this weekend for the team was obviously about going in to win, it also allows the team to become closer together and create that bond now which will come in handy in the

2025 is upon us and a new year means a new chapter for Apopka High School sports. Let's take a look at what's coming up in the next few months for Apopka Athletics.

2024 was a crazy year in general but for sports, it was a new frontier. From college to high school, name image and likeness (NIL) took over and conference as well as district realignment reared its head, and we saw the new look to our known conferences and districts at the college and high school level.

For Apopka, this year was long and less than spectacular when it came

to our playoff performances. For the boys' sports, Apopka's basketball, football, bowling, and volleyball teams all made it to the state championship playoffs but all were knocked out in the first round - except the bowling team who made it to the double-elimination round of the state

tournament.

For the girls' teams, it was similar, but Apopka's girl's wrestling team shined going to the State Championship meet with one of their girls finishing second. The girls' teams that made the state championship playoffs were the wrestling team and the flag football team.

Many of our teams made districts and had great showings but couldn't find their way into the state championship. It is Apopka's winning culture and mentality that pushes us to go for gold every year no matter the sport. Now while we may have been lacking in the skill department to

A look at the Wekiva Mustangs basketball teams

The Wekiva Mustangs basketball teams have had a rough go at it this season with teams sitting under .500 at the halfway point in the season. The girls team is 4-11 and ranked 243rd in Florida, while the boys team is 4-9 and ranked 308th in Florida as of Tuesday, December 31, 2024.

The girls are bouncing back from losing a lot of players from last season and injuries during this season. Last year, the girls were a final four team that competed against St. Thomas Aquinas in the Semifinal of the FHSAA State Championship. St. Thomas went on to win the state championship after beating Wekiva showcasing the Mustangs' potential.

This year though has looked completely differ-

ent as the team started 3-7 in their first ten games. Since then, the team has gone 1-5 and needs a huge turnaround to even consider a playoff run. The girls have scored 579 points and allowed opponents to score 751 points for a 172-point score differential so far this season.

The team's leaders on the floor are Makayla Bell, Senaia Asanya, and Jakayla

Colder weather may bode well for bass fishing

Hello Folks,

Happy New Year folks!! I hope and pray you had a Happy New Year and you are lookin' forward to this upcomin' new year.

We have some cold weather comin' our way in a few days. There has been some bass goin' on the beds, but they may have to delay their spawn if the water temperatures drop a whole bunch. So, if you have been plannin' a fishin' trip, you might want to try goin' a little sooner than you had planned.

Folks that have been goin' speck fishin' are still

doin' pretty good in most of the lakes and chains in our area. Folks are still catchin' specks in Lake Monroe, Lake Jesup, and the Kissimmee Chain as well. Most of the specks are bein' caught on minners driftin' in open water.

A few specks are startin' to bite on bright colored jigs tipped with a minner. Most of the specks that are bein' caught in Lake Jesup are under the Highway 417 bridge. So get you a bucket of minners and catch you some specks before this cold weather gets here.

The bass fishin' has been really good these past few weeks. A few bass were goin' on the beds and a few bass were already on the beds, with the males guardin' the beds. Most of the bass are bein' caught on shiners. The Kissimmee Chain and the headwaters

in Palm Bay have been producin' some great stringers of bass. A few double-digit bass are bein' caught on shiners. As the cooler weather moves in to our area, the bass will get pretty active and they will be feedin' on bait-fish in most of the lakes and chains in our area.

The Butler Chain is a great chain of lakes to fish, especially in the winter. The bass are feedin' on bait-fish gettin' ready to spawn. So, you have a good chance to catch some bass on shiners out there. Most of the bass are bein' caught by free-li-

nin' shiners out the back of the boat. You will have to fish around the submerged hydrilla and pepper grass patches to catch 'em.

Folks are catchin' some bass in the Maitland Chain by fishin' the same way. You need to fish the submerged hydrilla and eel-grass beds throughout the chain.

I wanted to let everyone know if you decide to go fishin' on West Lake Toho, the hydrilla is pretty thick throughout the chain. I have gotten some reports this week that the hydrilla is so thick that it's be-

comin' harder and harder to navigate the lake. So be careful if you are headed down there to catch some bass.

Well that's it for this week. I hope you had a great New Year and I'm lookin' forward to everyone's fishin' stories in 2025. See ya next week.

back that up the last couple of years no program tries as hard as every Apopka program to be the best versions of themselves. With that mentality kids and athletes that recognize the culture will come with their talents.

The beginning of 2025 holds promise though with the Apopka boys basketball team looking ready for a deep playoff run and the baseball and softball teams preparing for revenge tours after a less than spectacular end to their seasons last year.

Basketball

The Apopka boys and girls basketball teams are now in the second half of their season as they march toward the playoffs. The boys are 12-3 and ranked 45th in the state of Florida as of Tuesday, December 31, 2024. The girls are 3-7 and ranked 367th in the state.

The boys are in great contention for a playoff spot sitting at the top of their leaderboard and getting better every week. Head coach of the team Scott Williams has said multiple times that this year's team is capable of

making a deep playoff run with the right attitude and gameplan.

The boys have 11 games until the end of the regular season while the girls have 10. While the boys have a great chance at making the playoffs, the girls' journey will have to take a sharp turn here to be in contention.

The leaders for the boys' basketball team this season are Jude Angervil, Jermichael Johnson, and Jahi Bowden.

Angervil is averaging 13.6 points, 5.9 rebounds, .6 assists, 1.3 deflections, 1.4 steals, and 1.1 blocks per game this season while shooting 55.8 percent from the field.

Johnson is averaging 11.5 points, 6.3 rebounds, 2 assists, 1.8 deflections,

1.6 steals, and .5 blocks per game while shooting 47.4 percent from the field.

Bowden is averaging 8.9 points, 5.2 rebounds, 2.6 assists, 2.4 deflections, 2 steals, and .3 blocks per game while shooting 37.9 percent from the field.

The leaders for the girl's basketball team are Mikayla Wiggins, Jhenelle Francis, and Asia Jones.

Wiggins is averaging 9 points, 3 rebounds, 3.7 steals, and .7 blocks per game.

Francis is averaging 8.8 points, 2.7 rebounds, 4 steals, and .2 blocks per game.

Jones is averaging 8.5 points, 4.7 rebounds, 4 steals, and .2 blocks per game.

Soccer

Moving on to soccer, the boys and girls soccer teams are both having rough seasons with the girls outperforming the boys holding a 7-6 record to their 3-8-2 record. The girls are ranked 161 in Florida and 580 in the nation with boys ranked 365 in Florida and 1,414th in the nation.

The girls have just five games left in the regular season and the boys have just four games left. The girls sit in third of five teams in their district and need a win over district opponent Lake Brantley in order to move up the ranks. The boys sit in fourth of five teams in their district and need a miracle in order to create a playoff run for themselves.

The leaders for the

boys' soccer team this season are Aiden Acosta, Adrian Veloquio-Medina, and Garrett Perfater. Acosta is the team's centerpiece and has seven of the team's 15 goals this season. He also has three of the team's ten assists. Medina has three goals and no assists. Perfater has one goal and two assists.

The leaders of the girls' soccer team are Mackenzie Meyer, Robyn Pickard, and Neveah Nguyen. Meyer has seven goals and one assist this season. Pickard has six goals and two assists this season, and Nguyen has four goals and no assists this season.
